Greetings Sprayberry Soccer Families,

The Executive Board of the SHS Soccer Booster Club would like to welcome you to the 2012 Spring Soccer Season. We would also like congratulate your son or daughter for earning the privilege to represent Sprayberry in Region 5 AAAA competition.

The SHS Soccer Booster Club objectives are:

- To assist and support the Sprayberry Soccer Program
- To plan, organize and implement club support activities
- To provide funding through revenues generated from dues, fundraising, and concessions
- To promote good sportsmanship and represent the great SHS Community in a positive manner at all games and activities.

The Soccer Program is fully funded by player fees and concessions. We receive no financial support from the school other than to pay for bus transportation to/from away games. Fees for the 2012 season per player are \$325.00 (\$100 club dues and \$225 player fees). A \$25 discount is available for each player that pays his/her entire fee balance in full by Feb. 6, 2012. Families with multiple players pay only one club fee and the individual player fee for each member of their family making a team. Player fundraising credit earned will reduce fee balance due.

Players should fulfill their financial commitment to the club either by full cash payment or partial payment combined with fundraiser credit earned. The SHS Booster Club participates in multiple fundraising opportunities before/during/after the season. The club also offers individual payment plans as well as Financial Aid to those who find it especially difficult to pay the full fees. Financial Aid will cover the \$100 Club dues only. The remaining \$225 is the responsibility of the player.

Equally as important as the financial commitment is the volunteer hours required to run a high quality soccer program. There is no better use of your time than to show your support for your child and the club. Every family is required to work concessions at least one time during the season which will be counted towards the minimum number of hours as follows:

- Fees paid in full – 5 hours
- Financial Aid – 10 hours

Volunteer opportunities include Team Reps, Game Concessions, Middle School Night, Senior Night, Kickoff Banquet, Game Announcers, and Game Video Taping.

We look forward to meeting and working with all of you this season and in the years to come. Please feel free to contact any Board Member with questions, concerns or suggestions.

Sprayberry Soccer Boosters - Financial Aid Application

The Sprayberry Soccer program operates completely on monies collected through player dues and fundraising activities. We receive **no funding** from the school or county except for transportation to and from games. Funds are needed to purchase equipment/uniforms, field & facility maintenance, and for costs associated with banquets, awards and gifts. **The cost for the 2012 Soccer Season is \$325.00 (\$100 club dues /\$225 Player fees). Fees paid prior to Kick-off Banquet will receive a \$25 discount (\$300).** A Payment Plan or Financial Aid arrangement must be made prior to February 6, 2012. The following payment plan or aid arrangements are available:

- (A) **Payment Plan:** This allows a family to pay fees in up to 3 installments over the course of approximately 6 weeks. Fee balances must be paid in full **by Friday March 12, 2012. Please turn your payment plan agreement form into Tim Fleming at the Kick-off Banquet**
- (B) **Financial Aid:** Covers a waiver of Club fees (\$100) and is granted based on Financial need and is not based on playing ability. In order to determine eligibility, parents/guardians must complete the attached Aid Request form and return it to SHS Soccer Booster Treasurer Tim Fleming by **Friday February 3, 2012 (timothy.fleming@bms.com)**. This request is strictly confidential and all information provided will be used for the sole purpose of determining eligibility. This information will not be shared with anyone except Coaches and Club Administration. **PLEASE NOTE: PLAYERS REQUESTING FINANCIAL AID ARE REQUIRED TO PARTICIPATE IN ALL FUNDRAISING ACTIVITIES.** Note that some events such as Team Building, team meals, team T-shirts may not be covered by Booster Club fees. In such cases each athlete is responsible for his/her share of these expenses.
